Recruitment for Technical Position

- a) Translational Health Science and Technology Institute (THSTI) is an autonomous Institute of the Department of Biotechnology under the Ministry of Science and Technology, Govt. of India. THSTI is developed as a part of the interdisciplinary NCR Biotech Science Cluster located at Faridabad. THSTI is designed as a dynamic, interactive organization with a mission to conduct innovative translational research and to develop research collaborations across disciplines and professions to translate concepts into tangible products to improve human health.
- b) THSTI has set up niche centres for research in areas relevant to planned translational work. They are: Vaccine and Infectious Disease Research Centre (VIDRC), Paediatric Biology Centre (PBC), Centre for Bio-design & Diagnostics (CBD), Drug Discovery Research Centre (DDRC), Centre for Human Microbial Ecology (CHME) and Policy Centre for Biomedical Research (PCBR). Clinical Development Services Agency (CDSA) and National Bio-design Alliance (NBA) are THSTI's extramural centres.
- c) This recruitment is to fill up the vacancy of VIDRC under the project entitled "The animal facility for Research on Infectious Diseases".
- d) Vaccine and Infectious Disease Research Center (VIDRC) was set up with a mission to study and understand infectious diseases, their pathogens and host-pathogen interactions at the molecular and cellular level to generate translational knowledge to develop prophylactic and therapeutic measures against diseases prevalent in India.
 - VIDRC currently focuses on diseases like Dengue, Hepatitis, HIV/AIDS, Japanese Encephalitis (JE), and Tuberculosis (TB). To develop specific drugs and vaccines, animal models are required for their pre-clinical development. Besides, animals are extensively used for isolating novel infectious agents from patients for the purpose of diagnosis and therapeutic development. Since these animals carry infections during the experimentation, they are required to be handled in isolation and by specialized methods by trained technician. A specialised facility is therefore set up by THSTI for research on infectious diseases.
